Introduction to Private Investigation - BC Provincial Examination Requirements

Testing requirements to acquire a private investigator license may vary from province to province. If available, exam information is provided below. Otherwise, candidates are encouraged to contact their provincial government department for additional information.

Please submit your registration for the online exam at least two weeks in advance of your preferred date.

British Columbia

Candidates for a Private Investigator Under Supervision (PIUS) license must successfully complete the *Introduction to Private Investigation* online course (via PSKN) or its equivalent before registering for the exam. The exam must be completed under the supervision of a proctor and will be delivered at PSKN approved universities. See approved locations and scheduled exam dates below. Learners will be advised of the building/room location upon registration.

- The exam is delivered online by PSKN. **To ensure the exam runs properly on your computer, please use Internet Explorer as your browser.**
- Candidates must register for the exam via PSKN after they have successfully completed the *Introduction to Private Investigation* online course. .
- The exam registration fee is included in the course registration fee.
- Candidates must register at least two weeks in advance of the scheduled exam. **Registered candidates who cancel** (in the two weeks prior to the exam) **or fail to attend the exam will not receive a refund.**
- PSKN may cancel an exam session if insufficient registrations have been received. In these cases, registered candidates will be notified at the earliest possible date.
- The exam consists of 100 questions. Candidates will be given 2 hours to complete the exam.
- To pass the exam, a candidate must achieve 70% or greater. If a candidate fails to pass the exam, they may re-attempt the exam at the next scheduled sitting. The full registration fee applies to each sitting.
- PSKN will report all examination results to the Provincial Registrar.
